DETAILED ITINERARY



DAY 1 Shimla - Janglik (Base Camp)

- Drive: 150 km | 6–7 hours | Altitude : 9,200 ft
- Early morning departure from Shimla.
- Scenic drive via Rohru – Chirgaon – Tikri
- Enjoy stunning views of the Pabbar River between Rohru and Diude.
- After Chirgaon, the road turns into a dirt track; expect a bumpy but adventurous ride.
- From Diude, a short walk leads to Janglik village, the base camp.
- Reach Janglik, check into camps/guesthouse.
- Evening acclimatization walk & trek briefing.
- Dinner & campfire under the stars.
- Overnight stay in camps / homestay at Janglik



DAY 2 Janglik - Dayara Thach

- Trek : 5–6 km | 4–5 hours | Altitude : 11,200 ft
- Trek begins with a steep ascent through pine & oak forests (30 minutes).
- Trail opens into rolling meadows for about an hour.
- Gradual climb to a ridge offering panoramic views of Janglik, Tonglu & nearby villages.
- Walk through dense forests followed by vast open grasslands.
- Reach Dayara Thach, a beautiful alpine meadow.
- Relax, explore the surroundings, photography & sunset views.
- Overnight camping at Dayara Thach



DAY 3 Dayara Thach - Litham

- Trek : 6–7 km | 5–6 hours | Altitude : 12,000 ft
- Descend through forested trails and open meadows.
- Snow-capped peaks begin to appear as you move closer to Gunas Pass area.
- Trail descends towards the Chandranahan stream.
- Witness breathtaking views of the hidden Rupin Valley.
- Arrive at Litham, a wide campsite surrounded by mountains.
- Overnight camping at Litham



DAY 4 Chandranahan Lake Excursion (Acclimatization Day)

- **Trek: 5–6 km (round trip) | Altitude: ~13,900 ft**
- **Early morning start after breakfast.**
- **Cross a stream near Litham campsite.**
- **Follow shepherd trails climbing up to a ridge.**
- **Walk towards the snout of a waterfall – source of Chandranahan stream.**
- **Reach Chandranahan Lake, a sacred glacial tarn.**
- **Snow patches may still be present (especially in June).**
- **Return to Litham by lunchtime.**
- **Overnight camping at Litham**



DAY 5 Litham - Dhundi

- Trek: 5 km | 4–5 hours | Altitude: 13,200 ft
- Gradual ascent towards Nalabansh (13,000 ft).
- Enjoy contrasting views:
 - Green Litham meadows on one side
 - Rocky Rupin Valley cliffs on the other
- Walk along shepherd trails entering a U-shaped valley.
- Reach Dhundi, an alpine campsite surrounded by snow-clad peaks
- Overnight camping at Dhundi



DAY 6 Dhundi - Buran Ghati Pass - Munirang

- Buran Ghati Pass: 15,000 ft
- Munirang: 11,500 ft
- Early alpine start for summit day.
- Steep snow climb to Buran Ghati Pass.
- Spectacular views from the top.
- Technical descent using ropes on snow (adventure highlight).
- Descend nearly 3,000 ft into lush green valley
- Landscape changes dramatically with juniper plants, streams & shepherd huts.
- Reach Munirang campsite by evening.
- Overnight camping near the stream



DAY 7 Munirang - Barua Village - Shimla

- **Trek: 5 km | 3–4 hours**
- **Drive: Barua - Shimla (via Sangla / Reckong Peo)**
- **Easy descent through pine forests and juniper bushes.**
- **Cross a stream; apple orchards mark entry into inhabited areas.**
- **Enter Barua Village, a beautiful Himalayan settlement.**
- **Trek ends at Barua Khud road bridge.**
- **Drive to Sangla / Reckong Peo, then onward to Shimla.**
- **Trek Ends with Lifetime Memories**
